Central South Dakota Skating Club Volunteer Hour Guidelines

To help mitigate skating program costs, all families involved in the skating program are required to either volunteer their time for necessary tasks based on their skaters level, or pay on opt out fee of \$10 per volunteer hour required.

Volunteer Guidelines:

- Volunteer hours will be at the amount of highest level passed prior to start of that session.
- If a family has more than one skater, hours required will be of the highest skater's level.
- Hours are rounded up to nearest number of hours worked.
- Any hours not fulfilled will be assessed at the end of each session at a cost of \$10 per volunteer hour not completed. These hours will be billed, and that family will not be able to participate in skating with CSDSC the following session until the balance is paid in full.
- At the end of each session the volunteer hours reset to zero hours completed.
- Volunteers must be at least 13 years of age.
- All Families with skaters participating in the show/CSDSC competition will be required to assist with set up, tear down, decorating, and any other duties deemed necessary.
- An adult must be present at EVERY practice for safety reasons. If no adult is present practice can and will be canceled

Volunteer Opportunities:

Warming Room Parent: 1 volunteer per shift

- Sign up on Calendar posted at PAYSA
- Be there for your shift or make arrangements prior
- Duties: Helping with skates, pick up warming room, assist in case of emergency, ensure all skaters are picked up from rink before leaving, any other duties needed.

Music Player Volunteer: 1 person per shift during show/competition practices

- Must be in rink
- Sign up on Calendar posted at PAYSA
- Play songs for skaters as requested by Coach

Open Skate Volunteers: 2 Adults per shift

- Assist board member as follows: Sign-in, collect money, help fit and tie skates, monitoring ice for safety, snack sales, other duties as necessary
- Sign up on Calendar posted at PAYSA

Concession Volunteers:

- Assisting the club when raising money
- May include but not limited to: serving food, cleaning, handling money, receiving orders, other duties as necessary

Zamboni Driver:

- Willing to train
- Filling water
- Cleaning Zamboni after use
- Other duties as necessary

Show/Competition:

- -Greeters
- Concession stands volunteers at the EXPO
- Paper runners
- Cleaning the Expo
- Taking down glass around rink
- set up and tear down

Fundraising:

- Families are expected to participate in all fundraiser activities or events that promote the club.
- All Fundraising hours will count towards volunteer hours with the exception of; selling fundraiser items such as fruit, chocolate or any other item sold for the club will not be considered as volunteer hours
